



The California Integrated Mobility Program offers Remix transit service planning and scheduling software to California agencies

Under the leadership of Governor Gavin Newsom, and through a partnership between CalSTA and Caltrans' California Integrated Mobility Program, Remix Transit Service Planning and Scheduling software licenses are being provided to eligible agencies, for the first time ever, as part of our commitment to making it simpler for transit providers to access high quality, interoperable and GTFS-compliant products.

After years of research into the planning, scheduling, operational and technology needs of transit providers in the state, it is exciting to offer this opportunity to benefit transit agencies and all people in California.

What is being offered?

The California State Transportation Agency (CalSTA) purchased a limited number of licenses to Remix Planning and Scheduling software. Licenses will be offered to eligible providers at no charge for up to three years, based on eligibility criteria. Training and support will be provided at no additional cost to participating providers.

Our agency is interested. Are we eligible?

This program is offered to transit providers who meet the following criteria:

- Recipient of 5311 funding in the past 3 years **OR**
- Recipient of 5311 and 5307 funding in the past 3 years

We have a limited number of licenses available. For the first year of the program, priority will be given to agencies who have received only 5311 funding.

What else do we need to know?

This opportunity is being offered to transit providers who align with our goals to integrate schedules, improve transit operations and promote production and maintenance of high quality GTFS to improve the transit experience for all. As a participant, you will be asked to commit to meeting basic GTFS and scheduling goals, and our team is happy to assist along the way!
